New Initiative Highlights



Support for Caregivers

New this year, our professionally facilitated support group offers a safe space to share experiences and tools for managing personal health and better care for a loved one. **Now offered weekly and growing with group sizes of 5-10.**



Welcoming Youth in Transition

Our popular Transition Age Youth program provides continuing education inside and outside the classroom for our participants 18+. **Currently serving over 40 youth, we are working to double our roster in the next year.**



Expanding Independent Living

The demand for support to live in the community has never been higher for our participants. Our exceptional staff in the field are role models for new trainees who will help us **increase hours of coaching by 35% for our participants to live on their own, but not alone.**

- Health, Wellness & Clinical Services.



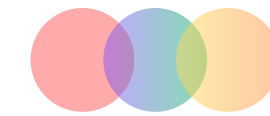

Individualized supports include:
